## Introduction

### What does it do?

Ameos Google PageRank is a frontend plugin that displays the Google's pagerank for the current Typo3 page.

## Users manual

Insert the plugin in the page content of your page, or invoke it in typoscript.

It will display the Google's pagerank for the current Typo3 page by inserting a simple image in the HTML, pointing to the Ameos Google PageRank service.

### Request

Ameos offers this service to the Typo3 community. [Typo3 Ameos](http://www.typo3.com) just ask users to keep the hypertext link pointing to the Ameos website (<http://www.ameos.com>) on the rendered image.

### How does it work ?

The frontend plugin renders an <IMAGE> HTML tag that targets the Ameos realtime Google PageRank service. This service bases itselfs on the REFERER parameter of the web browser that requests this image.

Ameos then determines the pagerank for the requested page, and returns an image displaying the pagerank ( for example :  
Rank 7 )

## What about the cache ?

We use a little trick to avoid problems due to the web browsers caching. The result of the md5() php function executed on the current URL is inserted in the image path. So each page has it's unique image path.

To prevent abusive utilization, the Ameos Google PageRank service will respond only if this md5 corresponds to the REFERER of the HTTP request.

## Configuration

You can configure the way the link displays by placing a css style named #tx\_ameosgooglepagerank\_pi1\_linkstyle in the css stylesheet of your site.

- Implementing a way to create statistics about the pageranks of your website, and their history.
- Allow user to choose the type of image being displayed ( standard, only the number, only the visual progressbar, colors, ... )
- Implementing a service that determines the *future* Google Pagerank ( active after the next GoogleDance )
