## Introduction

### What does it do?

This is a developer oriented extension created by [Typo3 Ameos](http://typo3.com). It allows to easily insert css, javascript, ..., in the <HEAD> tag of every Typo3 page.

## User's manual

### Inserting stylesheet

Use Ameos HTML Header in your extension as follows

```
$oAmeosHeader = t3lib_div::makeInstance("tx_ameoshtmlheader_pi1");  
$oAmeosHeader->initialize($this); // this refers to the current extension  
$oAmeosHeader->addCssHeader("fileadmin/userupload/mycss.css");
```

### Inserting javascript / anything else

Use Ameos HTML Header in your extension as follows

```
$oAmeosHeader = t3lib_div::makeInstance("tx_ameoshtmlheader_pi1");  
$oAmeosHeader->initialize($this); // this refers to the current extension  
$oAmeosHeader->addHeader("<script>alert('Hello World !')</script>", AMEOS_HTMLHEADER_TYPERAW);
```
